In June 2014, she participated in a Washington, D.C., roundtable discussion on campus sexual assault led by Missouri Sen. Claire McCaskill, and in December 2014, she testified before the U.S. Senate, addressing the topic of reducing sexual assault on campuses nationwide. Zoner became personally involved with IACLEA as a volunteer when she was asked to become one of the association's accreditation commissioners shortly after Cornell Police became accredited. Two years ago, she was also asked to chair the IACLEA Communications Committee. She will continue to volunteer in both capacities.
